Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include companies with Apple in their name, such as Apple Payments Inc., and others, including Apple Inc. and its subsidiaries.			
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Apple Payments does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.			
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <i>Apple Payments does not jointly market</i> .

If you are a California resident, we will only share your information with nonaffiliates if required to or permitted by California law.

If you are a Vermont resident, we will not share information we collect about you with affiliated or nonaffiliated third parties, except as permitted by Vermont law, such as to process your transactions or to maintain your account, or as authorized by you. We will not share information about your creditworthiness with our affiliates except with your authorization or as required or permitted by law.
